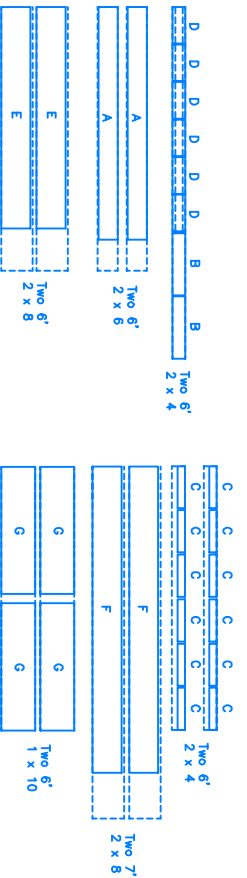
NOTES: Read all dimensions before beginning

- 1) Dimensions should be used to reinforce all joints
- 2) Set oil nails
- 3) Dimensions in brackets denote millimeters

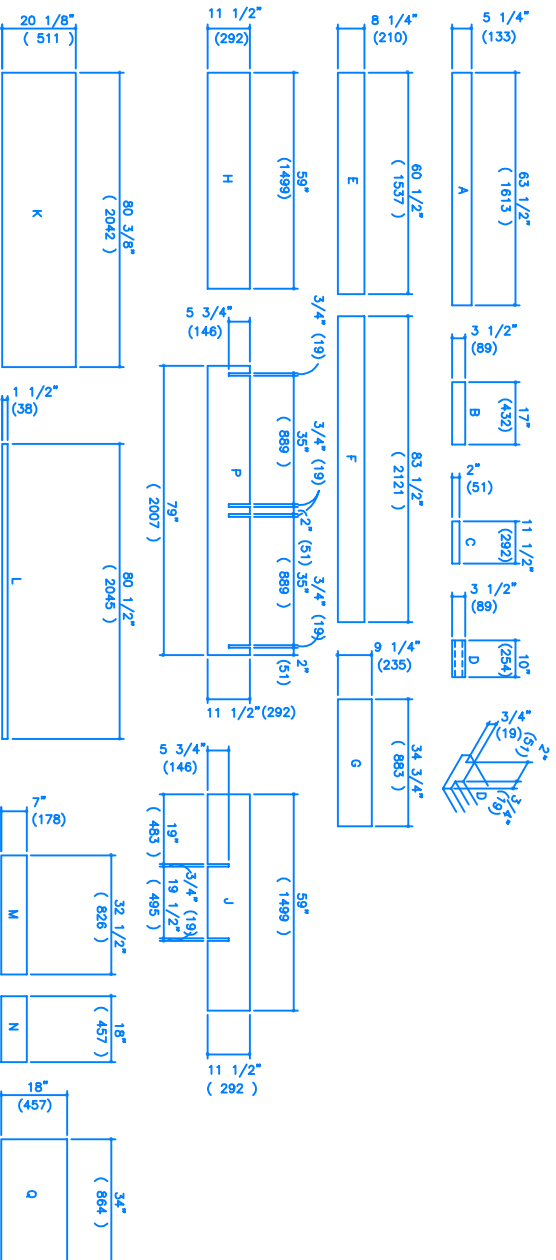
Directions

1) Lay out your material on the workbench as outlined in the suggested material layout (Fig 1). Draw out all parts exactly as illustrated in cutting diagram (Fig 2), including the letter designations. In pencil. Ensure to leave a small space between cut lines to allow for the width of the saw. Before cutting, double check all measurements to ensure they are correct. Always cut on the waste side of the line. Round the upper two ends of each piece A with a jigsaw, or cut off the corner and sand the corners. Round the lower two ends of each piece A with a jigsaw, or cut off the corner and sand the corners. Round the upper two ends of each piece D with a router or a table saw with a dado or regular blade. If you use a table saw, use a chisel to remove the waste. Measure and cut out the insets in I and J with a jigsaw, table saw or router.

MATERIALS LIST

- Approx. 1 lb. 1 1/2" finishing nails
- Approx. 1/2 lb. 1" finishing nails
- Approx. thirty six 2 1/4" #8 flathead screws
- Approx. eight 3 1/2" #8 flathead screws
- Approx. twenty four 2 1/2" #8 flathead screws
- Approx. sixteen 2 1/4" #8 flathead screws

MATERIALS LIST

- Two 6' 2x4 (1 1/2"x3 1/2")
- One 8' 2x4 (1 1/2"x3 1/2")
- Two 6' 2x6 (1 1/2"x3 1/2")
- Two 6' 2x6 (1 1/2"x3 1/2")
- Two 7' 2x8 (1 1/2"x3 1/2")
- Two 6' 2x8 (1 1/2"x3 1/2")
- Two 6' 2x10 (3 1/4"x3 1/2")
- Four 4x8' sheets 3/4" plywood, good both sides

MATERIALS LIST

- One 4x8' sheet 1/4" plywood (good one side)
- Stain and varnish, or oil
- Sandpaper & wood filler
- Four sets 1/2" side moulder & wood filler
- Four 3/8" wood buttons, or 8" of 3/8" wood dowel
